2. Reread pages 12-13. Why is it important to preserve our deserts?

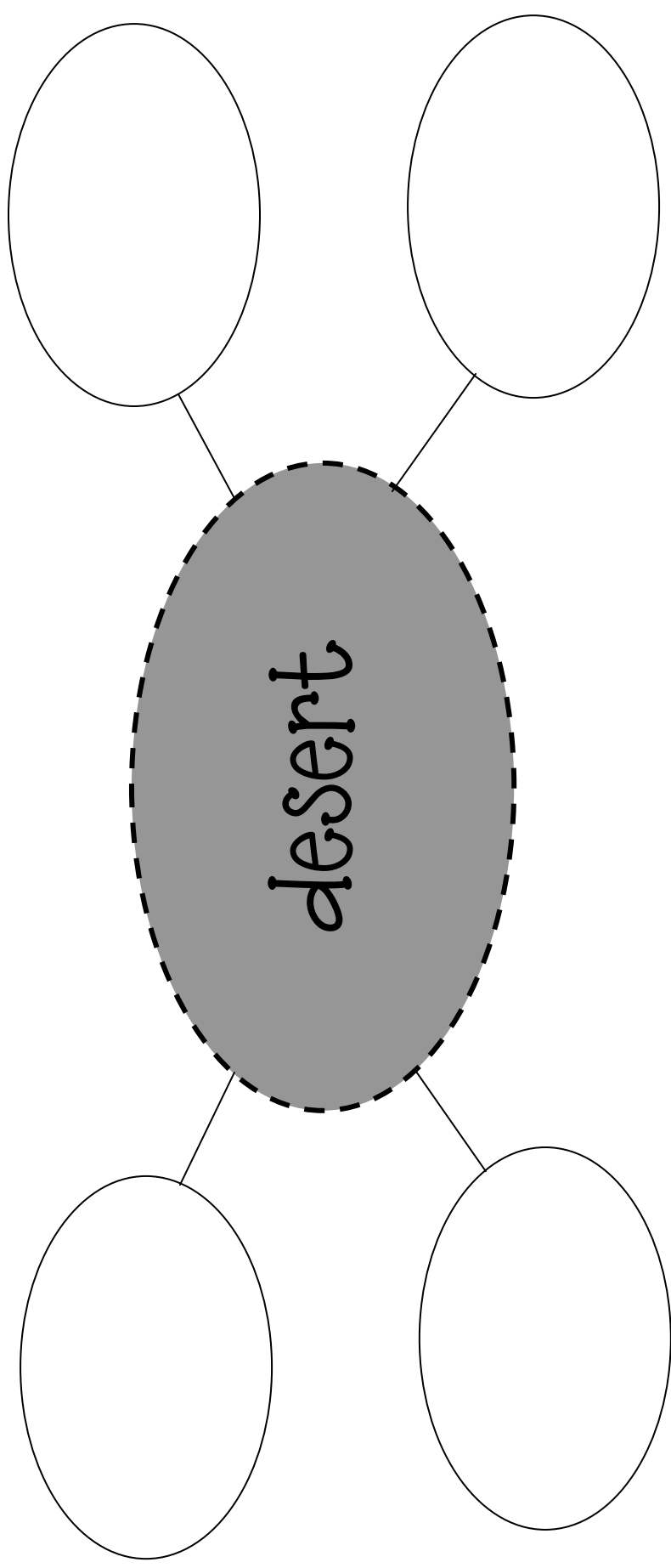
3. What part of this book did you enjoy the most? What other things would you like to know about the desert? Where can you find more information about it?

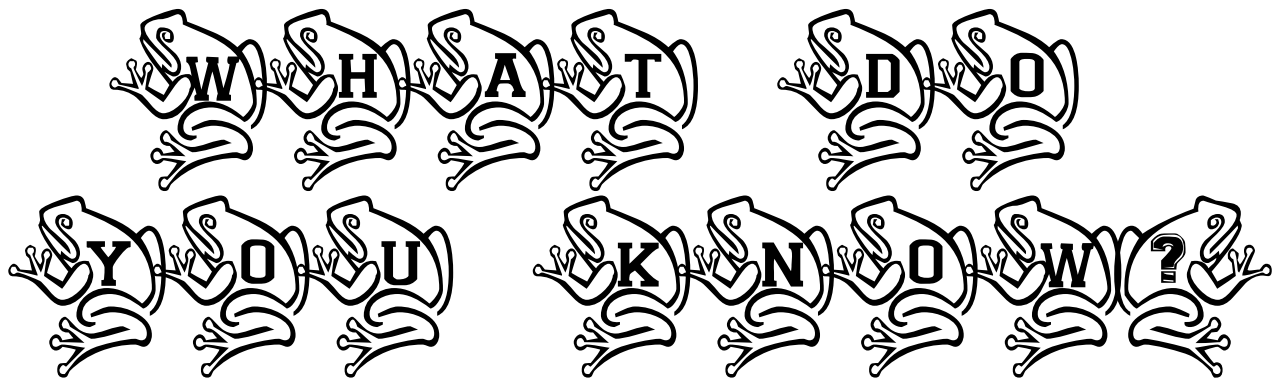
4. More and more people are moving into or near our deserts. To live in a desert, people need water. How might bringing more water to the desert affect plants and animals?
